

TIA RAPID ASSESSMENT CLINICS IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

Through support from the BCSS, a number of new TIA Rapid Assessment Clinics were established or expanded across the province. These clinics provide important tests and rapid intervention and management to greatly reduce the risk of an acute stroke, which can occur soon after a TIA. Below is a brief description of existing clinics and contact information for referrals. FRASER HEALTH AUTHORITY		AS OF MAY 2010			
Operates a network of three regional TIA Rapid Access Clinics. Patients meet with a neurologist and nurse, who specialize in stroke prevention. Together, a thorough neurological assessment is provided, and referrals for further testing or specialist consultations given. Patients also learn more on how to reduce their risk of stroke.

In Kamloops and Cranbrook , a nurse contacts patient for a detailed history after the referral is received, confers with the specialist, and arranges diagnostic tests and patient appointments. In Kamloops, patients meet with a neurologist; and in Cranbrook, with an internist to determine stroke risk, and to determine if further investigations or referrals are required. Education on stroke risk reduction and lifestyle modification is offered.

VANCOUVER COASTAL HEALTH AUTHORITY

Operates three. At **Lion's Gate Hospital**, a 24-hour centralized referral system is provided serving patients from the North Shore, Sunshine Coast, Whistler/Pemberton corridor and the North Coast. At **St. Paul's Hospital** and **Vancouver General Hospital**, clinics provide rapid access, assessment, investigations, expert opinion and evaluation by a stroke neurologist. Same-day access to CT head scans and angiograms, carotid ultrasound, laboratory testing and cardiac evaluations is provided. Referrals from family and emergency physicians and specialists are accepted and triaged. Emergent/urgent cases are typically seen within one week.
